Clothes Pin Angels

SOPPLIES:

Wood Clothes Pins

Wood Clothes Pin Heads

Wood Clothes Pin Bases (if you want them to stand by themselves)

Paints for painting heads

Glue Gun, Glue Sticks or a very tacky glue(I used a glue gun)

Craft Felt

Small gathered lace

Embroidery Thread

Light weight cut-a-way stabilizer

Vilene for Halo and Wings

HEAD:

Paint your head(s) the way you would like using the picture as a guide, then glue head to body.

Embroidery:

Hoop stabilizer -- Cut a piece of felt to fit inside of hoop and place on machine. Stitch out design. The first color is always the outline and it is best you stitch it the same color as the felt you use.

If you are using fabric I would suggest hooping the fabric along with the stabilizer.

After stitching remove from hoop and cut out. Cut just to the outside of the outline stitching.

You can now sew your pre-gathered lace to the bottom edge of the dress and sleeves.

Next wrap dress around your clothes pin doll. Overlap the back and glue together with glue gun.

Create a little cone with the sleeve and glue the overlap together then add a dab of glue at neck where you would like the arm to go and press sleeve into place. Repeat for other side.

Now glue the halo on top of head. You can add a ribbon to the back if you like before gluing wings in place so she can hang as a ornament if you like.
