4x4 Coin Purse

Materials:

- 1 3 1/4 inch flex steel closure
- Ribbon or cord for drawstring
- 2 pieces of material for the very top.
- 5 1/2 inch wide by 2 1/2 inch high for flex steel closure

Metal Internal Frame Kiss Clasp Arch For Sewing Handcraft Purse Bag 10cm/3.94"

These can be found on ebay, Amazon and most Hobby & Fabric Stores

- 5 1/2 inch wide by 6 inch high for drawstring
- 2 pieces of fabric for outside of purse, 4 1/2 inch square.
- 2 pieces of fabric for inside of purse, 4 1/2 inch square.
- Fabric or felt for Bunny Applique
- Stabilizer
- Embroidery Thread with Matching Bobbin Thread

Materials

Metal Internal Frame Kiss Clasp Arch For Sewing Handcraft Purse Bag 12cm/4.72"

These can be found on ebay, Amazon and most Hobby & Fabric Stores

- 2 pieces of fabric for tops
- 7"W x 6"H for drawstring

7"W x 2 ½ "H for flex steel closure (Metal Internal Frame Kiss Clasp)
2 pieces of fabric for front and back 5" W x 7" H
2 pieces of fabric for the inside 5" W x 7" H



To make the very top piece for flex steel or draw string
Turn in each side approximately 1 ½ " making the piece 4" wide.
Glue the edges down with a permanent glue. I prefer glue sticks like Scotch Glue stick
Permanent for Paper, Photos and Fabric.
Fold in half and place it fold side up and just about ¼" to ½" below the first placement stitch.



Hoop Stabilizer

1. Stitch onto stabilizer. This is a placement stitch.

Remove hoop from machine and place the very top piece, folded in half, with raw edge just below the line as shown below.



Secure in place.

2. Zig Zag tack down stitch.

Trim as shown above.

3. Placement Stitch



Place a piece of the inside fabric, face down over area, making sure it overlaps the top lines.

Then place a piece of the outside fabric, right side up, over the area as shown above.

Secure in place and return to hoop.

4. Stitch the tack down stitch

Remove hoop from machine and trim the the top overlap. Return hoop to machine.

5. Zig Zag tack down stitch



For this next color make sure that your Bobbin Thread matches the Top Thread. This is the Satin Stitch for the top area and the bobbin thread will show.

6. Final Satin Stitch.

Remove from hoop, Tear out stabilizer, Spray some adhesive between the 2 layers of fabric and press the together. Set aside.

This is the Front of the Purse.

Hoop Stabilizer

First 3 steps are the same as above.

1. Stitch onto stabilizer. This is a placement stitch.

Remove hoop from machine and place the very top piece, with raw edge just below the line.

Secure in place.

2. Zig Zag tack down stitch.

3. Placement Stitch

Place a piece of the outside fabric over area, making sure it overlaps the top lines.

4. Tack down stitch. This is done in a small basting stitch so that it can be picked out if it shows when finished.

Applique

5. Outline stitch for Bunny

Stitch, remove hoop from machine and place a piece of fabric over area. Secure in place.

Return hoop to machine.

6. Tack down outline

Stitch, remove hoop from machine. Trim around applique area. Return hoop to machine.

7. Zig Zag Tack down Stitch around applique.
 8. Black for Eyes and Mouth
 9. Pink for Nose
 10. Color of choice for Satin Stitch and detail for Applique.
 11. Remove hoop from machine, turn over to backside and secure a piece of inside fabric, face up and secure in place. Return hoop to machine.
 12. Tack down stitch for inside fabric.
- Remove hoop from machine, turn over and trim around tack down stitch
13. Satin Stitch for top raw edge. Make sure your bobbin thread matches your top thread.
 14. Now we will place the back onto the purse.
- Remove hoop from machine, Turn over to the back.

(If you want, before placing the back piece on, You can carefully pull the stabilizer off the back of the design.)

Place the back piece with the inside fabric facing down, Match up the Satin Stitch lines.
Secure in place so that the piece won't move when placing it back onto the machine.
Stitch the tack down stitch.



Tack down stitch. Remove hoop from machine, turn over and trim around the stitch line.

Return to machine

15. Zig Zag tack down stitch
16. This is the final Satin Stitch. Make sure that the bobbin thread matches the top thread.
Remove design from hoop.

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5x7

Materials

2 pieces of fabric for tops

7" x 6" for drawstring

7" x 3" for flex steel closure

2 pieces of fabric for front and back

2 pieces of fabric for the inside 5" x 7

Finishing the Tops.

For Drawstring

Cut 2 lengths of cord or ribbon approx 3 times the flat width of the coin purse

Thread 1 end thru both sides of top, tie a knot with the 2 ends.

Repeat with the 2nd piece, starting at the opposite end. You will now have a knot at each side.

Pull both ends to close the top.

For the Flex Steel or Metal Internal Frame Kiss Clasp

Insert each end into each side of the top.

Put the open end together and insert the tiny rod that comes with it, into the end.

Close one end of the clasp.
