

FESTIVE FSL BASKETS (3 sizes)



1. Hoop 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer and adjust the pieces as they fit.
2. Mesh type stabilizer is best like Vilene and polyester thread is recommended!
3. As with all free standing lace, fill the bobbin with the same top thread.
4. Slow down your machine for trouble free sewing.
5. Make sure the thread tension is perfect for a good finish to your lace.
6. You need to embroider 5 pieces of the side panel and 1 of the base.



7. Once done, trim the excess stabilizer and rinse under running water.
8. Rinse just enough to rinse away the stabilizer but don't overdo it as we need the stiffness for stability.
9. Let the pieces dry flat and when almost dry, cover with a pressing cloth and iron to give a neat finish.
10. If desired add rhinestones, sequins or any other decorations.
11. Use your sewing machine with a zigzag stitch and adjust the width to properly join the edges.
12. Use either a clear nylon thread or the same thread as used for the satin edges.
13. Join all the side panels first except the last edge, then join the base finishing with the last side panel edge.(last edge of panels can be hand sewn for convenience)
