

Instructions for

FSL Light Switch and Outlet Plate Covers

These free standing lace light switch plate covers will fit in a 6 x 10 embroidery hoop.

Using two layers of water solvent stabilizer pick the design of your choice to stitch out.

When the design is finish stitching, rinse out the stabilizer and lay flat to dry.

There are three ways you can attach the light cover to your light switch plate:

1. Using quick set glue, align the glue all the way around the plate front. From the back side of the design align the flips up and press onto the plate hold for a few minutes until dry.
2. Using double side tape outline all the way around the front of the light plate and pressed the back side of the design on.
3. Lay the FSL light switch cover front face down, unscrew the cover plate from the wall and lay on top and align the design and plate. With a large needle gentle press thru the screw hole of the plate so you know where to replace the screws when the plate is screwed back onto the wall. An example of what it would look like attach to the wall is below. Happy stitching.
