## Halloween Lights

Materials needed

Tear away Stabilizer

Threads

Assorted colors of felt aprox 3 1/2" square for each design.

String of LED twinkle lights.

Make sure they are LED because the standard bulbs get hot and might pose a Fire hazard.

In the samples, small battery operated LED lights were used. But both sizes Will work.

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**Basic Instructions:** 

Hoop the Tear A Way stabilizer.

These 2 colors can be stitched in the same color.

Color 1: Stitch on Stabilizer.

Remove hoop from machine and place the felt over the outline. Return to Machine

Color 2: This is the outline stitch and detail for the design. Be sure and

Use a contrasting Color that will show up.

Basic Instructions for Hole:

These 2 colors can be stitched in the same color.

Stitch the hole outline, remove hoop from machine and carefully cut out the Center of hole.

Next Color is the satin stitch outline for the hole.

These 2 steps can be stitched in the same color.

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Halloweenlights\_001 Bat

All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color

Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions

Stitch Colors 3 & 4 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

Remove from hoop, glue or sew beads for the eyes.

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Halloweenlights\_002 Bat with Eyes
Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions
Color 3: Yellow Bat Eyes (or color of your choice)
Stitch Colors 4 & 5 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

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Halloweenlights\_003 Plain Witch Hat
All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color
Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions
Stitch Colors 3 & 4 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.
Remove from hoop, glue or sew beads for decoration or leave plain.

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Halloweenlights\_004 Stars Witch Hat All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated. Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions Stitch Colors 3 & 4 as described in the basic instructions for the hole. Color 5: Yellow Stars

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Halloweenlights\_005 Spider

All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated.

Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions

Color 3: Red for Black Widow Hour Glass

Stitch Colors 4 & 5 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

Remove from hoop, glue or sew beads for eyes.



Halloweenlights\_006 Spider with stitched eyes

All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated.

Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions

Color 3: Green for Eyes or color of choice

Color 4: Red for Black Widow Hour Glass

Stitch Colors 5 & 6 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

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Halloweenlights\_007 Jack o' Lantern
All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated.
Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions

It's best to use black or a dark brown thread so that the detail will show up on the orange pumpkin.

Color 3: Green for Stem, or color of choice

Color 4: Yellow for Jacks face

You can continue in yellow for the next 2 steps since the light will be Jacks Nose. Stitch Colors 5 & 6 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

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Halloweenlights\_008 Plain Spider Web
All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color
Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions
Stitch Colors 3 & 4 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.
Remove from hoop, glue or sew beads for decoration if you want.

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Halloweenlights\_009 Beware Spider Web
All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated.
Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions
Stitch Colors 3 & 4 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.
Color 5: Red for the wording BEWARE or color of choice.
Remove from hoop, glue or sew beads for decoration if you want.



Halloweenlights\_010 Jack o' lantern with out eyes

All Colors can be stitched with the same thread color unless stated.

Stitch Colors 1 & 2 as described in basic instructions

It's best to use black or a dark brown thread so that the detail will show up on the orange pumpkin.

Color 3: Green for Stem, or color of choice

Color 4: Yellow for Jacks face

You can continue in yellow for the next 2 steps since the light will be Jacks Nose.

Stitch Colors 5 & 6 as described in the basic instructions for the hole.

Remove from hoop, glue or sew on beads, buttons or googly eyes.
