Holiday Mug Rugs

Follow regular charts for Holiday Rugs #1, #3, #5, #7, & #8, before last color change lay your fabric then batting on top of the design right sides facing together. Follow instructions below for Holiday Rugs #2, #4, #6.

CC stands for Color Change Supplies: Fabric of your choice for top & bottom, cut pieces at least 6"x7" cotton batting Thread of your choice

HolidayRug_2

Hoop main fabric. Place hoop on machine and follow steps below.

- CC1 Quilting stitch
- CC2 placement stitch for center fabric After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.
- CC3 Tack down stitch
- CC4 Satin stitch
- CC5 lettering

After lettering place a piece of fabric right side down covering all stitching then lay cotton batting on top and stitch next CC.

CC6 - Sews front to back leaving a opening.

Remove from hoop when done. Trim leaving about 1/8 inch seam allowance and turn right side out and sew open closed.

<u>HolidayRug_4</u>

Hoop main fabric. Place hoop on machine and follow steps below.

CC1 - Quilting stitch

- CC2 placement stitch for center fabric After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.
- CC3 Tack down stitch
- CC4 Satin stitch
- CC5 lettering

After lettering place a piece of fabric right side down covering all stitching then lay cotton batting on top and stitch next CC.

CC6 - Sews front to back leaving a opening.

Remove from hoop when done. Trim leaving about 1/8 inch seam allowance and turn right side out and sew open closed.

HolidayRug 6

Hoop main fabric. Place hoop on machine and follow steps below.

CC1 - Quilting stitch

CC2 - placement stitch for tree top fabric - After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.

- CC3 Tack down stitch
- CC4 Satin stitch

CC5 - placement stitch for tree middle fabric - After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.

CC6 - Tack down stitch

CC7 - Satin stitch

CC8 - placement stitch for tree bottom fabric - After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.

CC9 - Tack down stitch

CC10 - Satin stitch

CC11 - placement stitch for tree trunk fabric - After stitching place fabric over top of stitching.

CC12 - Tack down stitch

CC13 - Satin stitch - After stitching trunk place a piece of fabric right side down covering all stitching then add cotton batting and stitch next CC.

CC14 - Sews front to back leaving a opening.

Remove from hoop when done. Trim leaving about 1/8 inch seam allowance and turn right side out and sew open closed.
