

ITH FABRIC TRAYS-

5x5, 6x6, 8x8 & 9x9



You will need-

Fabric, fleece and/or batting- 1 inch bigger squares than the size you are making.

Eg.-If making an 8x8 inch size, use squares of size 9x9 inches.

1. Hoop tear away stabilizer and sew the 1st color, the placement line.
2. Lay a layer of batting or fleece and a piece of fabric right side facing up.
3. Sew the 2nd color, the tack down stitch.

4. Continue and complete the design changing colors as desired.



5. Remove hoop from machine, turn it over and lay a piece of fabric at the back of the hoop. (right side facing upward)
NOTE: At this stage fill bobbin with same thread as the top.
6. Secure the 4 corners with tape, put the hoop back on the machine and sew the outline which will join all the layers together. Also stitch the inner square.
7. If any part of the design is remaining, complete stitching that.
8. If you want the satin stitch edge (use this option if you have used regular fabric which can fray). Remove hoop and trim the excess fabric from all the layers as close to the stitching as possible.
9. Get the hoop back on the machine and stitch the satin edge.
Remove and un-hoop.
10. If not using the satin stitch option, no need to remove hoop and trim excess fabric. Just skip the satin stitch edge and sew the last color, which is the triple stitch outline.

11. Remove and un-hoop, carefully trim all 4 sides.
12. You need to mark a line perpendicular to the inner square.
13. To form the trays, you may use snaps, ribbons, sew by hand or using sewing machine.
