

ITH Key Chains/Fobs

All made to fit the 5x7 hoop, can be resized up to +/- 20%!



Bunny/Peace/Mom Key Fobs







Things you will need:

1. Top fabric (Big- 2.5x6 inches approx.)
2. Fleece or felt or any light batting (same size as the top fabric)
3. Any kind of key ring.

Step 1-

Hoop a piece of tear away and stitch the 1st color.

(Use same color as your top fabric so you can change color for the 3rd stitch)

Step 2-

Place your top fabric covering the whole of the outline, you can tape it if you want or just hold it in place for some time. Stitch out the 2nd outline which will tack down your fabric.

Step 3

Change thread/threads to that of your design and complete the stitch out till mentioned below....

* In the bunny key chain stop and do step 4 before the last 2 colors (after the face has been embroidered)

* In the MOM key chain stop and do step 4 before the last 3 colors (after the hearts have been embroidered)

* In the peace key chain stop and do step 4 before the last color (the final outline)

Step 4

Remove the hoop from the machine and place the fleece/felt/batting on the back side of the hoop covering the design well from all sides, tape it in place.

Step 5

Stitch out the last outline which will attach the 2 layers together. (Your tear away is sandwiched between the 2 layers)

Step 6

Unhoop and remove the excess stabilizer. Neatly cut around the whole design $1/8^{\text{th}}$ inch away from the stitching. (Careful not to cut the outline stitches and maintain consistency so as to match both halves of the key chain)

Step 7-

Slide the key ring to the mid of the keychain, apply some glue on 1 half leaving some portion in the middle clean. (You don't want to stick the key ring)



Stick the 2 halves together, let it dry and you can still trim a bit if any cutting is uneven.

NOTE: Another option is to sew together the 2 sides on a sewing machine, making sure the stitches blends in.

Clover key chain



Things you will need:

Top fabric (Big- 2.5x6 inches approx.)

Fleece or felt or any light batting (same size as the top fabric)

Green applique fabric

Any kind of key ring.

Step 1-

Hoop a piece of tear away and stitch the 1st color.

(Use same color as your top fabric so you can change color for the 3rd stitch)

Step 2-

Place your top fabric covering the whole of the outline, you can tape it if you want or just hold it in place for some time. Stitch out the 2nd outline which will tack down your fabric.



Step 3

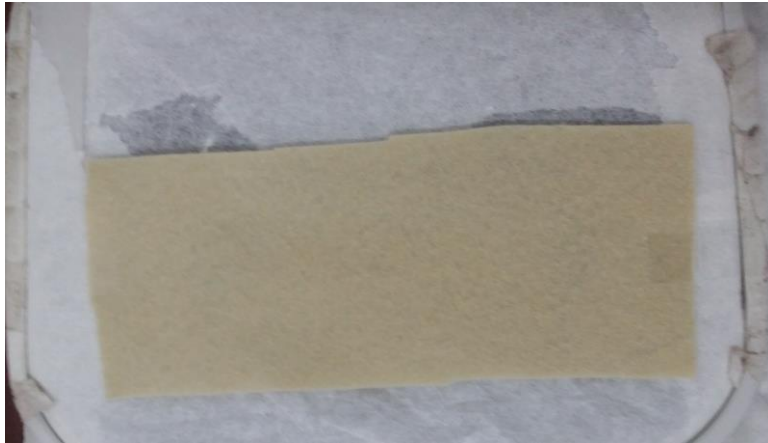
Lay the applique fabric covering the whole of both the leaves and sew the next color.

Change thread/threads to that of your design and complete the stitch out of the face.



Step 4

Remove the hoop from the machine and place the fleece/felt/batting on the back side of the hoop covering the design well from all sides, tape it in place. Sew the next outline.



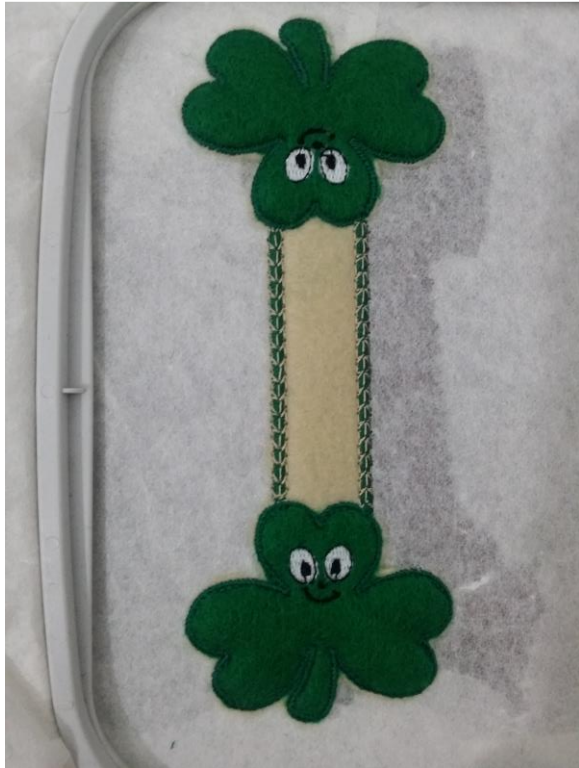
Step 5

Remove the hoop and trim the excess fabric as close as possible all around, like we do for an applique (both top and bottom)



Step 6

Complete the satin edges and decorative stitch.



Unhoop and remove the excess stabilizer. Neatly cut around the whole design $1/8^{\text{th}}$ inch away from the stitching. (Careful not to cut the outline stitches and maintain consistency so as to match both halves of the key chain)

Step 7-

Slide the key ring to the mid of the keychain, apply some glue on 1 half leaving some portion in the middle clean.
(You don't want to stick the key ring)
