

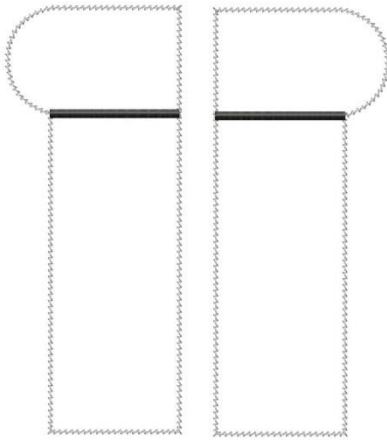
In The Hoop

REQUIREMENTS

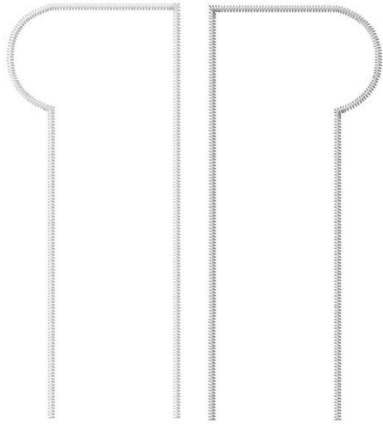
- Hoop
- Tear-a-way backing
- Fabric
- Thread
- Bobbin
- Applique scissor
- Cotton Filling (legs)



LEGS

1. Hoop only Tear-a-way backing
2. Stitch out the legs and shoes using applique accordingly
3. Make **2 sets** separate for the front and back
4. **DO NOT** remove the last set from the hoop
5. Take the 1st set (wrong side up) and line the two sets up to form the front and back side of the legs
6. Make sure the satin stitch match the set still in the hoop





LEGS (B)

1. Stitch the back and front legs together

➤ Optional

You may also use your sewing machine to attach the front and back legs together



2. Turn the legs inside out

3. Fill with cotton filling

✓ Legs are done, set aside



BODY

1. Hoop as follow:

- Tear-a-way backing
- Fabric for the cushion / cover

2. Stitch out the body using applique accordingly

3. **STOP** at the last marker stitch at the bottom

4. **DO NOT** remove from the hoop when done



ATTACH BODY AND LEGS

1. Adjust the legs to the desire length by removing from the filling
2. Put the filled legs on the bottom of the body (still in the hoop)
3. Make sure the 2 legs are even
4. Stitch the zig zag, to secure the legs to the body

5. Cut the unwanted fabric and complete with satin stitch (using applique method)
