

# ITH Soft Toy – Worm

*(No Sewing Machine Needed)*



## Need the Following:

- 10 color blocks (6'x6') / (15cm x 15cm) – body
- 2 white blocks (6'x6') / (15cm x 15cm) – face
- 2 white blocks (6'x6') / (15cm x 15cm) – tentacles
- 4 x Cotton or Curtain cord – legs
- 8 color blocks (6'x6') / (15cm x 15cm) – feet
- Machine Embroidery Thread - White, Black, Light pink
- Tear away
- Scissor, glue/needle thread
- Cotton filling for soft toys

## Step 1 – Tentacles

1. Hoop tear away
2. Stitchout the Marker stitch on the tear away (stitch 1)
3. Place the first fabric (right side up) on the marked lines
4. Place the second fabric (wrong side up) on the first fabric
5. Stitchout the final stitch (stitch 2)
6. Remove from the machine
7. Cut out the tentacles
8. Turn the fabric inside out
9. Fill with cotton filling



## Step 2 – Face

1. Hoop tear away
2. Stitchout the Marker stitch on the tear away (stitch 1)
3. Place the first fabric (right side up) on the marked lines
4. Stitchout the stitch 2 to secure the face
5. Stitchout the face (3:light pink, 4:black, 5:white)
6. Stitchout stitch 6 and 7, these are the markings where the tentacles are placed



7. Place the Tentacles over the face to the inside. Make sure they are placed correctly and not over the outlines. Here you can decide how long you want them
8. Stitchout stitch 8 and 9 to secure the tentacles.
9. Place the second fabric (wrong side up) over the face outlines



10. Reduce the machine speed. Stitchout the final stitch. Keep the fabric in place while the machine runs the outline

11. Cut out
12. Turn the fabric inside out and fill with cotton filling. Close the hole with hand stitch or fabric glue

### Step 3 – Body (x 5)

1. Hoop tear away
2. Stitchout the Marker stitch on the tear away (stitch 1)
3. Place the first fabric (right side up) on the marked lines
4. Place the second fabric (wrong side up) on the first fabric
5. Stitchout the final stitch (stitch 2)
6. Remove from the machine
7. Cut out the Body
8. Turn the fabric inside out
9. Fill with cotton filling
10. Close the hole with hand stitch or fabric glue



### Step 4 – Feet (x 8)



1. Hoop tear away
2. Stitchout the Marker stitch on the tear away (stitch 1)
3. Place the first fabric (right side up) on the marked lines
4. Stitchout stitch 2 and 3
5. Applique: Cut out the Feet
6. Stitchout the final satin stitch
7. Remove from the machine Pull all 3 stitches together to form the perfect round feet



8. Fill with cotton filling
9. Place your feet secure on both sides on your leg
10. Run the leg between the 2 body parts
11. Secure with needle stitch or fabric glue
