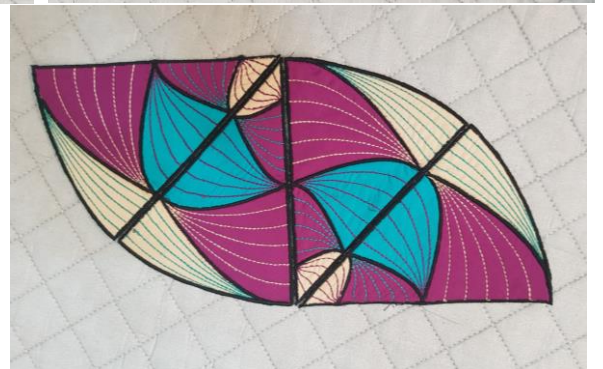
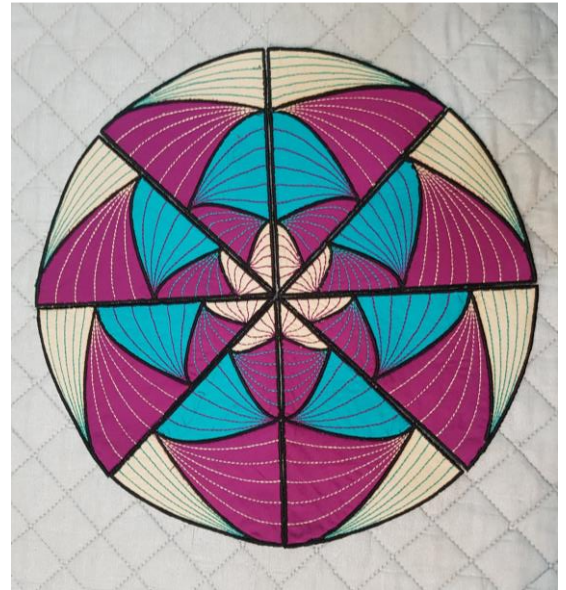
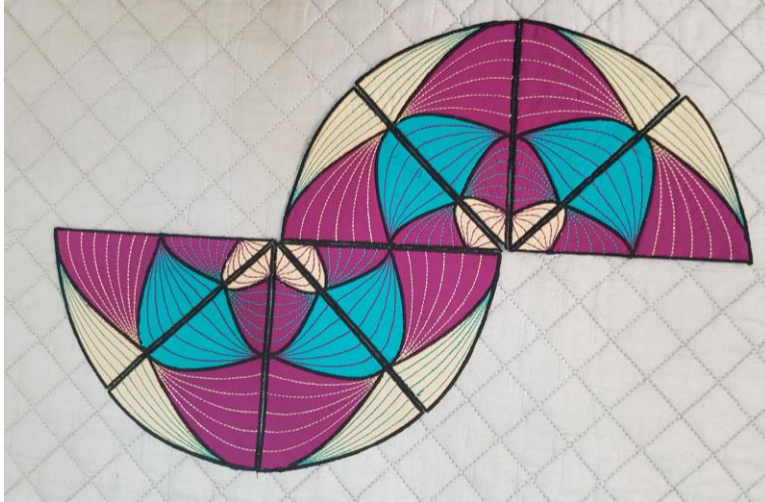


ITH WHIMSICAL TABLE RUNNER/TOPPER (4x4, 5x7 & 8x8)



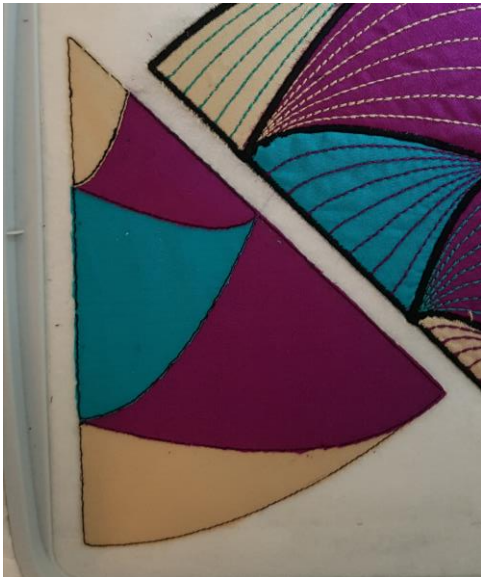
Different color scraps of fabric for the top layer

Batting/fleece

Backing fabric (not necessary if using fleece as backing)

Tearaway stabilizer

1. Hoop Tearaway stabilizer and use a basic thread color for color stop 1-6. Sew the 1st color which is the placement line for all the 5 pieces.
2. Lay a piece of fabric covering the outline of the 1st section. Sew the 2nd color, remove hoop and trim all the excess fabric.
3. Lay the fabric for the 2nd section. Sew the 3rd color, remove hoop and trim excess fabric.
4. Repeat same process for all the 5 section, completing the top layer.



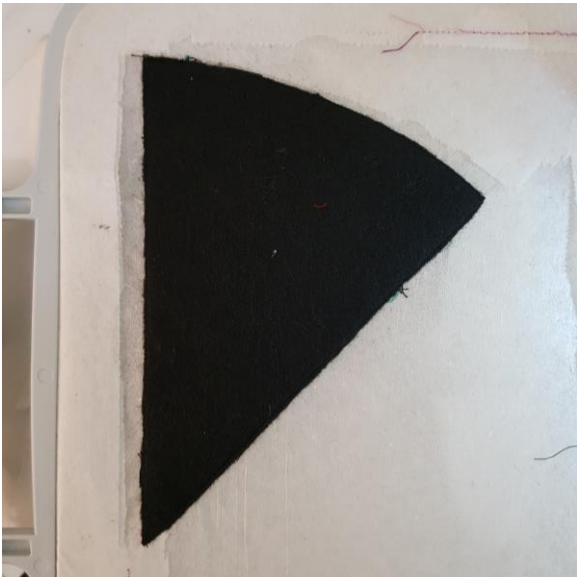
5. Change threads as needed and complete the decorative stitching on all the 5 pieces. (these can be skipped if you wish to keep it plain) These are color stops 7-11.



6. Remove hoop and lay the fleece at the back of the hoop covering the outline and tape it in place. If using batting, lay a layer of batting and over it lay a piece of the backing fabric, secure properly. (another option is to add batting under the top layer instead of the back before the fabric scraps are pieced)

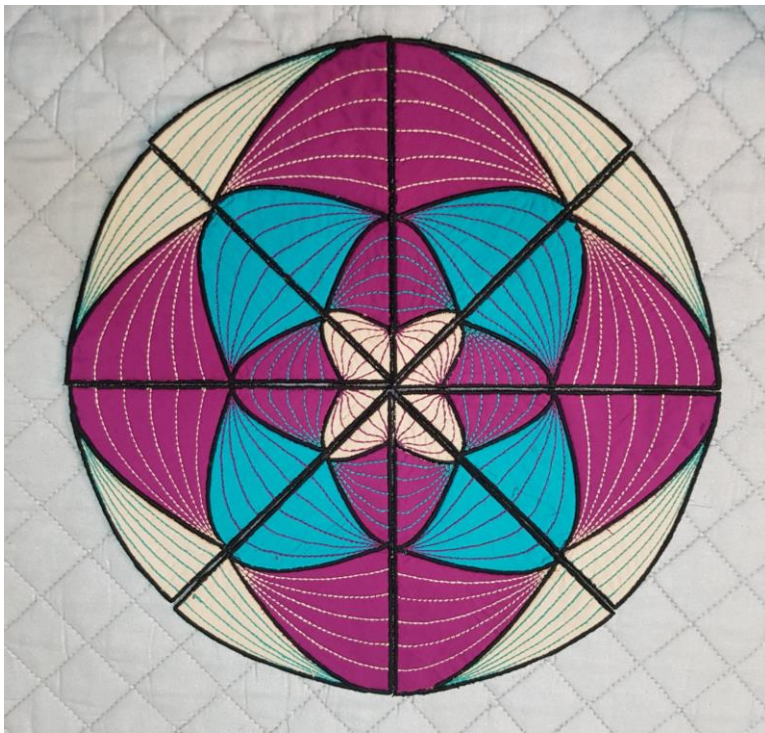


7. Sew the next outline, remove hoop and trim all the excess fleece/fabric/batting.



8. Change thread color for the satin edges, fill bobbin with the same color.

9. Stitch the last satin edge stitching. (this may be skipped if you wish to have a raw edge finish or if you have used non-fraying materials)
10. Remove un-hoop and tear away all the excess stabilizer.
11. Make as many as needed for the pattern you are creating.
12. For a circle table topper you need total 8 pieces, 4 of each left facing and right facing.



13. Using a sewing machine set on a suitable width zigzag stitch, join the pieces and get the needed pattern and size.
