

## ITH POUCH/BAG/WALLET/PURSE/CASE/CLUTCH (4x4, 5x7, 8x8 & 8x11)



1. Hoop tear away stabilizer and sew the 1<sup>st</sup> color, the placement line.
2. Lay a layer of thin batting or fleece covering the outline, top it with a layer of fabric with right side facing up. Tape it in place and sew the 2<sup>nd</sup> color. (you will get the pocket placement line as well)



3. Next change colors as desired and complete the decorative stitching. (color stop 3, 4 & 5)



4. Next lay the fabric for the pocket following the size guide for different size of bags. Making sure it is aligned with the placement line, tape it in place and sew the 6<sup>th</sup> color which will tack down the pocket.



5. Lay the lining fabric on top, right side facing down covering the whole outline. Tape it in place and sew the last partial outline.  
NOTE-For the bigger sizes or if your fabric is not very thick, you may add another layer of fleece along with the lining. (Lay it on top of the lining)



6. Unhoop, Tearaway all the excess stabilizer and trim the bag carefully leaving 1 cm seam all around, leave a little extra at the opening.



7. Better to trim away all the excess batting or fleece from the seams to remove the bulk. Turn the bag inside out through the opening.
8. Hand sew and close the opening. Sewing machine can be used as well.
9. Finally turn the pocket right side out, iron well and add snaps or Velcro for closing.

#### FOR THE POCKETS-

4x4"- Use a piece of fabric 6"x5", fold in half to get 3"x5".

5x7"- Use a piece of fabric 8"x9", fold in half to get 4"x9".

8x8"- Use a piece of fabric 11"x10", fold in half to get 5.5"x10"

8x11"-Use a piece of fabric 12"x13", fold in half to get 6"x13".

Sandwich a layer or 2 of fleece between the fabric layers for extra thickness if needed.
