Materials needed and Notes:

Stabilizer

Green Fabric

Optional Felt

4" green zipper

Green Ribbon

Eyelet for Chapstick holder

Decorative Snap closure for Key Fob

If your pressure foot hits the zipper head, I may knock it off balance.

In this case it is best if you remove the hoop from the machine, turn it off, let it reset and then fast forward to where you left off.

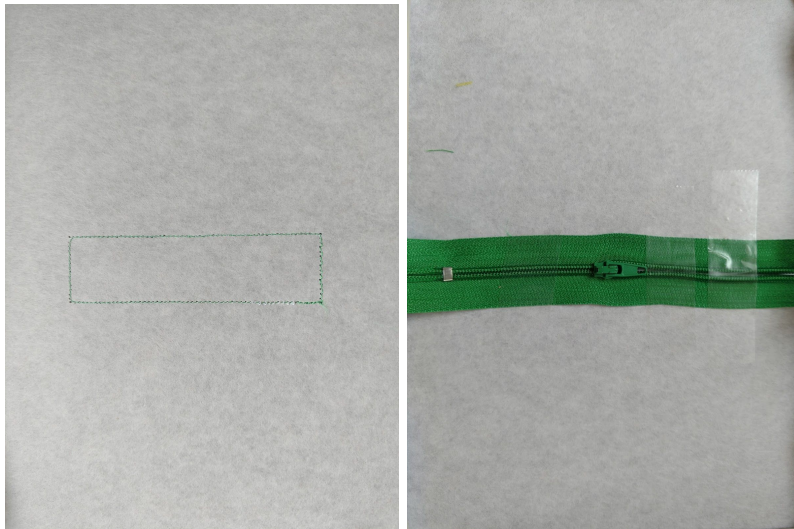
It's best to stitch a little of the satin stitch for zipper, stop your machine and then slide the zipper back behind the stitching so that you won't have to worry about the pressure foot hitting it.

1. Hoop 2 layers of tear away stabilizer.

Stitch the 1st color of the design.

This is the Zipper placement line.

Remove hoop from machine



Spray adhesive onto the stabilizer over the placement lines. Or carefully secure ends with pins.

Lay down a plastic zipper and put the zipper handle in the middle from the zipper sides

Return hoop to machine

2. Stitch the next color in the design.

Zig zag tack down to keep the zipper in place.



Remove hoop from machine

Cut both ends of the zipper off

Return hoop to machine

3. Stitch the next color

Purse outline placement

Now cut 2 pieces of fabric large enough to cover the design area.

1 for the purse front and 1 for the pouch lining.

Then a piece of optional medium weight batting or light weight 6x6

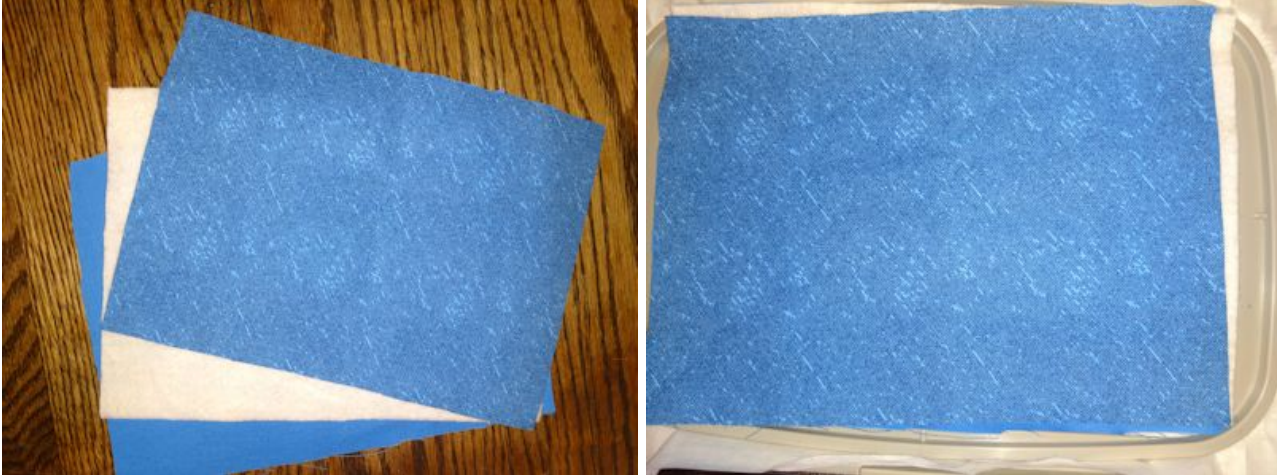
Make a fabric sandwich bottom layer first as follows

Pouch lining, right side down, batting in center, house material face up

Place this fabric sandwich on top of the house outline area and secure

Make sure that the Front of house fabric is on top. Plus make sure the zipper pull is in the middle and not fully closed.





4. Stitch the next color

This is the tack down for the purse outline

5. Stitch the next color

This is around the zipper area

Remove hoop from machine

Carefully cut around the "inside" of the zipper area. Cut through all layers so that you can see the zipper. Trim around the purse area as you would for applique.

Return hoop to machine

6. Stitch next color.

This is the zigzag around the zipper.

7. Stitch next color.

This is the satin stitch around the zipper area. Please be sure to stop the machine occasionally to move the zipper pull in a better position so that the needle has room to stitch without hitting it.



Remove hoop from machine.
Turn hoop over so the bottom is showing.



If you would like to. Carefully remove the stabilizer from the back of the design area. DO NOT remove the design from the stabilizer.

Remove it 1 layer at a time.

This is a big timesaver. If you do it after the item is finished, you'll have to tear it thru the zipper opening.

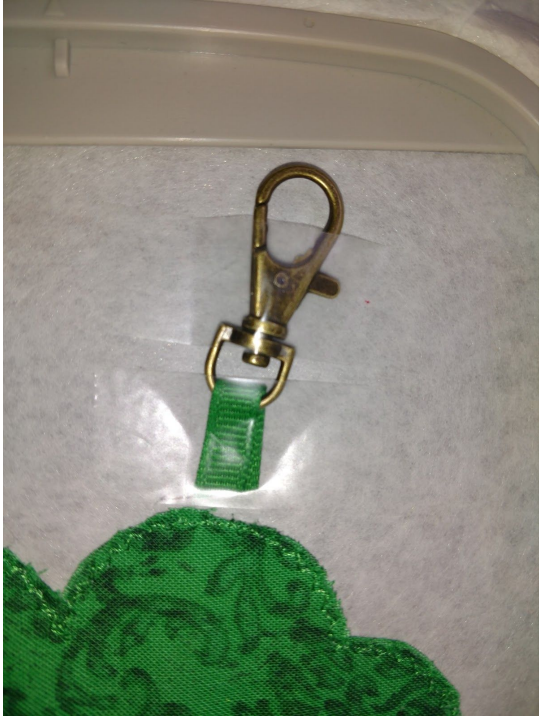
You can add a piece of wide ribbon at this time for a loop. Make sure that it is "under" the fabric sandwich. Tape in place as shown above.

An easy way is to make a small slit in stabilizer, push the ribbon thru the hole to the backside as shown.

Make another fabric sandwich as before.

While hoop is still upside down and secure the fabric sandwich to the bottom of the hoop.

Make sure the house fabric is Right side up and the inside of the purse fabric is facing right side down.



Return hoop to machine.

8. Stitch next color. Tack down stitch for purse.

Remove hoop from machine and trim around the house like you would applique.
Be careful to not cut the ribbon.

See picture above.

Return hoop to machine.

9. Zigzag tack down

Be sure and have matching bobbin thread for these next 2 colors, as shown above. The bobbin thread will show.

10. Stitch next color. This is the final satin stitch for the purse.

Remove hoop from machine and then remove house purse from hoop



Hoop stabilizer

1. Stitch outline onto stabilizer
2. Remove hoop from machine

Secure your material over the outline area

Return hoop to machine

Stitch next outline stitch

Remove hoop from machine

Trim around design as you would for applique

- Return hoop to machine
3. Stitch outline area for clover
Remove hoop from machine
Secure a piece of fabric over outline
Return hoop to machine
 4. Outline stitch for clover
Remove hoop from machine
Trim around area as for applique
Return hoop to machine
 5. ZigZag stitch around clover.
Remove hoop from machine
Secure a piece of fabric onto the bottom of the hoop.
Return hoop to the machine.
 6. Stitch the zigzag outline.
Remove hoop from machine.
Turn hoop over and trim around the design as you would for applique.
Return hoop to machine.
 7. Make sure your bobbin thread matches the top thread till the design is finished.
Stitch the Satin Stitch for the Tab.
 8. Stitch the Satin Stitch for the Clover.

Remove from hoop and place a snap Top on lower part of the front of the design.

Turn the design over and place a snap on upper part of the tab.

Fold the tab over and snap it to the back of the design.



1. Stitch Outline onto stabilizer

Remove hoop from machine and place a piece of felt, material of choice or vinyl over area. Return hoop to machine.

2. Stitch outline

Wait until finished to trim as for applique.

3. Stitch Clover Placement

Remove from hoop and place a piece of felt or vinyl over the heart area.
At this time you can change colors to match your Heart material.

4. Stitch tack down stitch for clover

Remove hoop from machine and trim around around clover.

Remove hoop from machine and turn over to backside

Place a piece of material for the back over the design area and secure.

Turn the hoop back over to front. Using the stitched guide line, place a piece of material approx. 1/8 to 1/4 inch above the line so that the line will not show.

This is the pocket.

Return hoop to the machine.

With same color as the decorative stitch, stitch the next color.

5. With color that matches the background, Stitch the sides and top of the design.

6. Stitch the decorative stitch around the clover.

Remove from hoop and trim.

Fasten an eyelet to the top of the design using an eyelet setting tool.
