Materials Needed:

2 squares fabric for 4x4 hoop. 1 for front of design and 1 for the back or bottom.

Optional: thin piece of batting.

Step 1:

Hoop stabilizer and secure 1 piece of fabric onto stabilizer with a glue stick, spray adhesive or basting stitch.

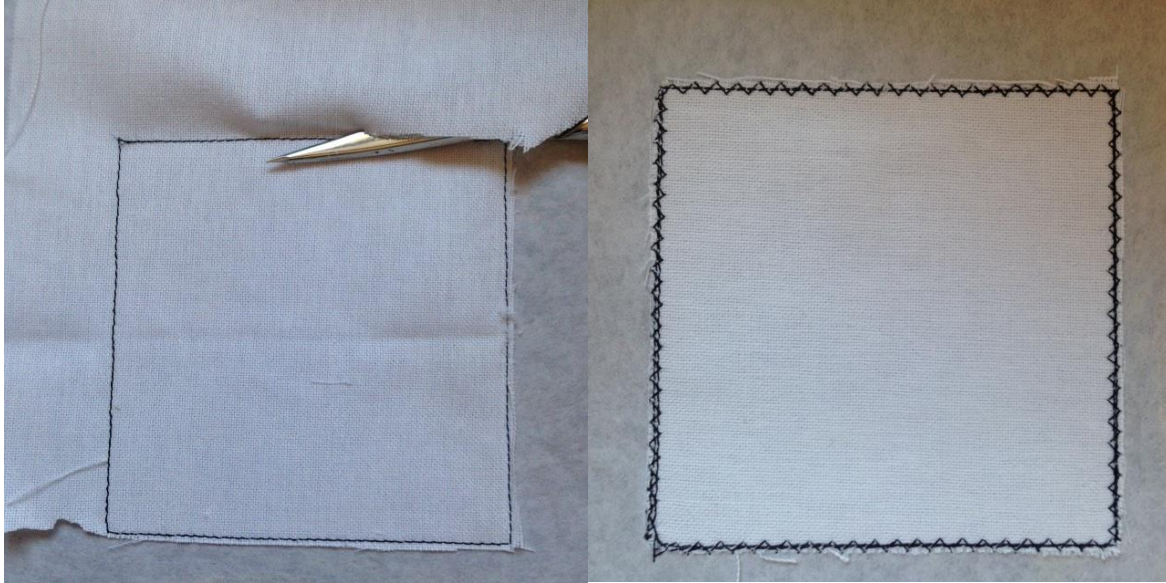
Stitch Color #1

Remove hoop from machine and cut around design like applique.

After cutting all the way around the outside of the design area, return hoop to machine.

Stitch Color #2

This is the zig zag tack down stitch as illustrated in the pictures below.



Stitch the main design according to the color chart for each design.

Step 2:

Remove hoop from machine and turn upside down or the bottom facing up. Glue the optional piece of batting along with the backing piece of fabric.

Return hoop to machine.

Stitch the 2nd to the last color.

This is the tack down stitch. Remove hoop from machine and trim around the design as noted in the pictures below.

Stitching the Border

First you need to make sure that the bobbin thread matches the main thread color. Return the hoop to the machine and Stitch the Final Color. This is the final satin stitch border. At this point you should “Float” an extra piece of stabilizer under the hoop. The needle may cut all the way around the design.
