

ITH Heart Shaped Baby and Elephant Banner

The best Heart Shaped Baby and Elephant Banner ever! ITH Heart Shaped Baby and Elephant Banner is made with fabric and wadding, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:00 hours

Materials:

- 5" x 7" and 6" x 10" embroidery hoop.
- White, Grey, Light Grey, and printed cloth Fabric Sheets Pcs.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Needle and white thread
- Fabric scissors
- Wadding

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the bottom heart garland tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the 1st color-stop as a placement line.



Step 2:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



Step 3:

Cover the wadding with white fabric.



Step 4:

Run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3 to fix the fabric.



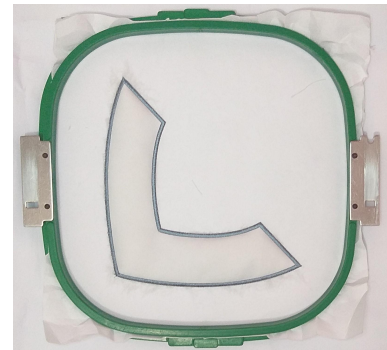
Step 5:

Cut off the excess fabric.



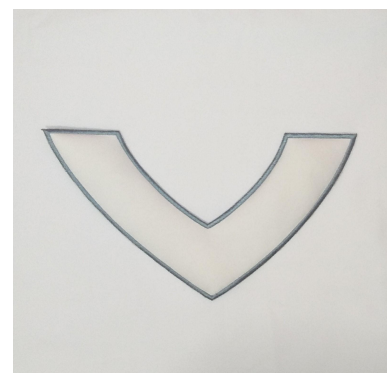
Step 6:

Run color-stop 4.



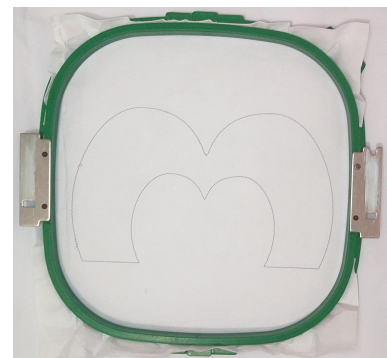
Step 7:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 8:

For the top heart garland tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the 1st color-stop as a placement line.



Step 9:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



Step 10:

Cover the wadding with white fabric.



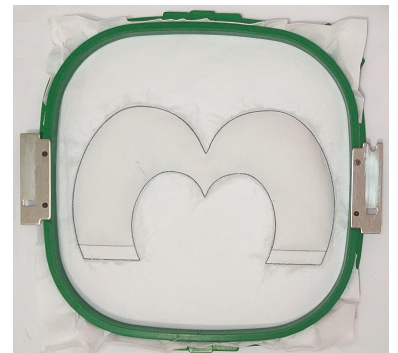
Step 11:

Run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4 to fix the fabric.



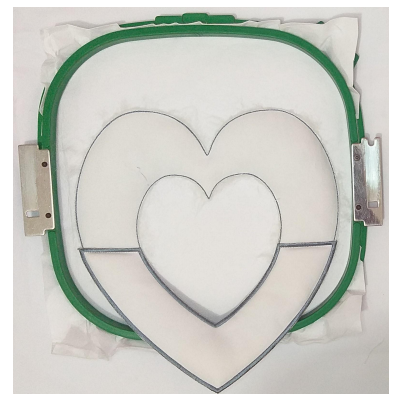
Step 12:

Cut off the excess fabric.



Step 13:

Arrange the bottom heart garland so that both pieces together form a heart and repeat color-stop 4 to fix the pieces.



Step 14:

Run color-stop 4.



Step 15:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 16:

For the Elephant tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the color-stop 1 and color-stop 2 as placement lines.



Step 17:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



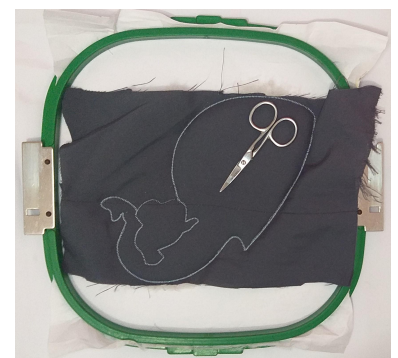
Step 18:

Cover the wadding with grey fabric.



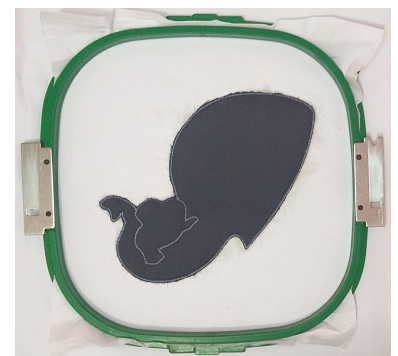
Step 19:

Run color-stop 3 to fix the fabric, then cut off the excess of it.



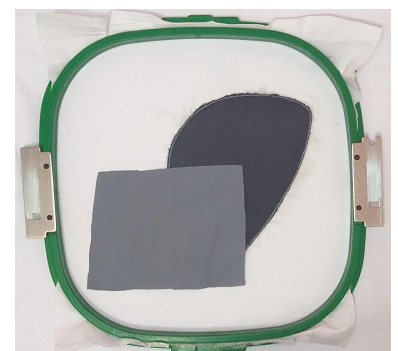
Step 20:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line.



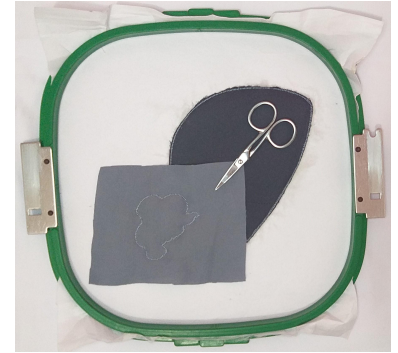
Step 21:

Cover the placement line with light grey fabric.



Step 22:

Run color-stop 5.



Step 23:

Cut off the excess fabric.



Step 24:

Embroider the rest of the color stops of the design until the embroidery is finished.



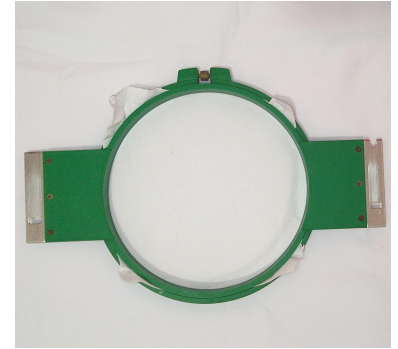
Step 25:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 26:

For the Cloud tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 27:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



Step 28:

Cover the wadding with white fabric.



Step 29:

Run color-stop 2 through color-stop 3.



Step 30:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric.



Step 31:

Run color-stop 4.



Step 32:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



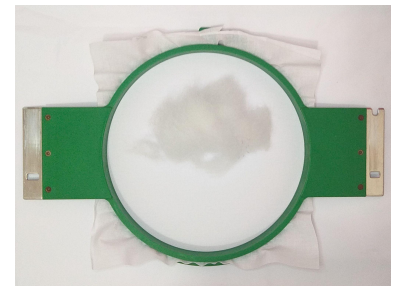
Step 33:

For the ballons tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 34:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



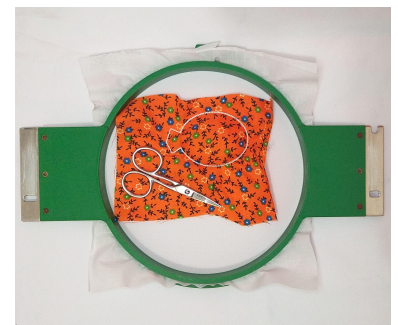
Step 35:

Cover the wadding with printed cloth fabric.



Step 36:

Run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3 to fix the fabric.



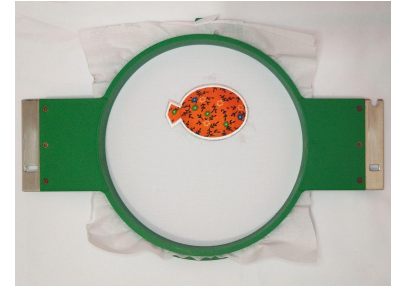
Step 37:

cut off the excess fabric.



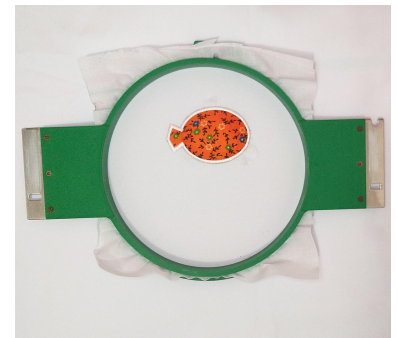
Step 38:

Run color-stop 4.



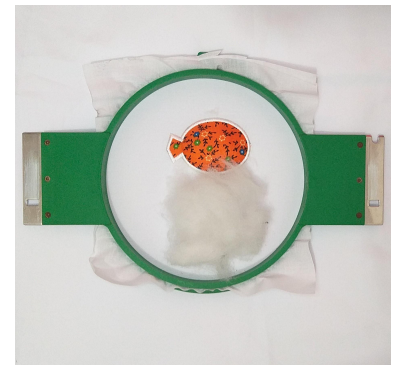
Step 39:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line.



Step 40:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with wadding.



Step 41:

Cover the wadding with printed cloth fabric.



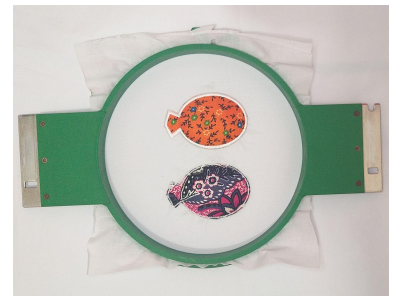
Step 42:

Run color-stop 6 and color-stop 7 to fix the fabric.



Step 43:

cut off the excess fabric.



Step 44:

Run color-stop 8.



Step 45:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors.



Step 46:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, join the pieces as they are arranged in the image. Use colored cord as a complementary decoration for the balloons, and make sure to place a cord to hang it. Have fun doing this beautiful project.
