

Make these for Mini Candy Treats or to slip a Gift Card.

You can stitch on any color of fabric or even 2 tone. A solid color with the design and a matching pattern fabric on the back.

The first and then the final steps can all be done in thread that matches your fabric.

Hoope with tear away stabilizer and stitch color #1. This is the stabilizer. Remove hoop from machine and place a piece of fabric over the outline. Make the piece longer so that you have plenty of fabric on the top to make a nice tie.





With tape or a washable glue stick, secure the fabric to the stabilizer. I prefer using a washable glue stick. If you prefer, you can back up your machine and stitch the 1st color over again to secure.

Continue stitching the actual design.



After you have finished with the design area, you can change back to the color that matches the material.

The next color is the ribbon placement as shown below. Place the center of the Ribbon over the placement line and stitch the next color. Tape in place.



Stitch the tack down stitch for the Ribbon. Then remove the tape as shown below.

Take the 2nd piece of material and cover the design area making sure that the ribbon is clear of the stitching line around the design area. Secure in place.



After stitching the last color, remove design from hoop and carefully pull the tear away stabilizer back off. With decorative scissors, trim around the design and the top being careful that you do not cut the ribbon that is layered in the center.



Turn the back inside out. You can then tie the ribbon into a bow and insert a Gift Card.



Or fill with mini candies, wrap the ribbon around the top and tie in a bow for a great party saver.
